Educational Leader Section:

We would like to share with our families more about why we do what we do. This is a goal in our new Quality Improvement Plan for 2017/2018. We do have reasons behind what we do and we would like to share more with our families. At our staff meeting in the holidays we discussed the following question.

Why do we have shared meal times with the children?

- It promotes communication skills
- It allows time for discussions occur about healthy eating in a real context
- Educators and children eating together allows educators to set a good example to the children about what to eat and how to eat as well, to be role models.
- It provides for social interactions between children and educators and between children. Yes there is opportunities all day but some children play a great deal by themselves and this time gives them safe and supported opportunity to develop their social skills.
- · Provides familiar routine for children
- Provides opportunities for turn taking and waiting for each other which occurs all throughout life so is preparation for life.
- Families don't always get to sit together as a family we find in society and we like to provide for this time at Preschool.
